Kent Youth's offices are located in the Medway Council owned Youth House building, home to a number of third sector children & young people's organisations and public sector agencies.

The Youth House itself is sited in a Campus with New Brompton College, Bradfield College and KEY Training, a vocational training centre for young people.

As well as providing a community of organisations working with children and young people, the Youth House offers shared training/meeting facilities and some limited back office functions, thus enabling economies of scale to be achieved.

The offices of Kent Youth are located on the first floor of the Youth House.

## ***Car Parking***

Car parking at the Youth House is free but the car park can sometimes be busy. It is a controlled car park during office hours and you need to display a Visitor Car Park pass for inside your windscreen. You can obtain a car park pass on your arrival at our office or arrange for one to be issued in advance of your visit. If you are attending an evening or weekend meeting or training session, there is no need to obtain a car park pass.

## ***From the car park***

As you face the Youth House building from the car park, you should go along the left hand side of the building. This path takes you away from the car park between the Youth House and the Brompton College.

Keep the Youth House building on your right at all times and turn right at the building's corner, down the slope past the grass and trees.

At the bottom of the slope, turn right again past the raised flower beds. The Youth House entrance is in the corner.

## **By train**

The Youth House is a 15 minute walk from Gillingham mainline station. Walk along the high street between the shops. Continue all the way through the shops until you get to Marlborough Road (the Black Lion Leisure Centre is on your right). Turn left up Marlborough Road for approximately 6 minutes until you reach the Youth House and car park. Taxis can be found on Railway Street the station. If no taxis are available, two local companies can be contacted on 01634 222 222 and 01634 582 582.

## **By car on A2/M2 from London**

Where the A2 meets the M2 join the A289 towards Gillingham. At the roundabout (Four Elms roundabout) where the A289 meets the A228, take the second exit towards Gillingham.

At the next roundabout where the A289 meets the A22 keep in the nearside lane and take the 1st exit (Anthony's Way) towards the Medway Tunnel.

At the following roundabout take the first exit and head through the Medway tunnel.

Branch left at the tunnel exit (sign posted Chatham A231) and take the 3rd exit towards Chatham into Maritime Way.

Go across the 1st roundabout into Dock Road. At the next roundabout at the top of the hill, take the 1st exit into Brompton Road (A231), sign posted to Gillingham.

Go through 2 sets of traffic lights and pass a playing field on your right and the Black Lion Leisure Centre on your left. Take the next right turn (which is a wide junction with parked cars down centre of the road) into Marlborough Road. Follow up Marlborough Road and the Youth House and car park is on the right hand side after the playing fields.

## **By car on M2 from Canterbury**

Exit at Junction 4 signposted Gillingham. Follow the A278 towards Gillingham, straight across roundabouts until you reach the third roundabout. At this roundabout turn left towards Gillingham.

Continue along A2, straight across roundabouts. This is A2 Rainham Road. You may also see it called Watling Street and Sovereign Boulevard (these are all names used for the same road).

You will pass a petrol station on your left, continue straight ahead. You will notice the shops lay back from the road at the point of a right and left turn, keep in the middle here and continue straight ahead.

Continue on as the road narrows to one lane. You will pass several small roads on the right hand sides which have no right turn. Continue until you reach a set of traffic lights and a church on your right. Turn right here into Rock Avenue.

Take the third turning on the left at the traffic lights into Montgomery Road, then turn right at the mini roundabout into Windmill Road, followed by the next left into York Avenue. Follow York Avenue to the end, turning right into Marlborough Road. Turn left in to the Youth House car park at the end of the long hedge. Make sure you do not turn left in to the earlier Brompton College car park. The Youth House car park entrance is just before the zebra crossing.
